Study questions for 1st Corinthians 1

v3 Was this just a standard salutation of Paul or does it really fit the situation?

v4-7 How could they 'not be lacking in any (spiritual) gift' and yet be so messed up?

v8-9 When will they (and us) be finally blameless?

v10-11 What is the first problem Paul brings up?

v12-16 Where did the problem start? Do we see this problem today?
v17 Is water baptism the way to salvation? Why is baptism not a part of the Gospel?
v18-25 Why does God use the simple announcement of the Gospel instead of miracles?
