Study questions for 1st Corinthians 15

(vs1-11 The Gospel)

- vs1-2 By which you are saved
- vs3-4 Christ died...was buried and...He was raised
- vs5-8 He appeared
- vs9-11 We preached and so you believed

(vs12-58 The Ressurection)

- v12 Some among you say there is no resurrection
- vs13-19 If there is no resurrection...
 - v13 Christ is not raised
 - v14 Our preaching is vain
 - v14 Your faith also is vain
 - v15 We are...false witnesses
 - v16 Christ has not been raised!
 - v17 Your faith is worthless!
 - v17 You are still in your sins
 - v18 Those...fallen asleep in Christ have perished
 - v19 We have hoped in Christ for this life only
 - v19 We are of all men most to be pitied
- vs20 Christ has been raised!
- vs21-28 In Christ all will be made alive
 - vs21-22 As in Adam all die
 - vs23-24 Christ the first...after that those who are Christ's...then the end
 - vs25-28 He must reign (the Millenium) until He...abolished death
- vs29-34 If the dead are not raised...
 - v29 Why then are they baptized for them?
 - vs30-31 Why are we also in danger?
 - v32 What does it profit me?
 - vs33-34 Do not be deceived
- vs35-50 How are the dead raised?
- vs51-52 We will not all sleep, (the Rapture) but we will be changed!
- vs53-58 Death is swallowed up in victory.

- Find the answers to the following questions <u>in</u> the verses under consideration!) vs 1-2 Why does it say "by which you are saved" instead of "which saves you"?
- vs 3-4 Where does it say, in this presentation of the <u>full</u> Gospel, that physical healing is a part of the Gospel? (cf. Galatians 1v6-12)
- v 12 Who "among you" (Christendom) would say there is no resurrection of the dead?
- vs 13-19 How many reasons are given to prove the resurrection in this verse?
- vs 29-34 How many more reasons are given to prove the resurrection?
- vs 23-24 What is the chronological order of the resurrection? (cf. Rev 20v5-6, 11-14)
- vs 25-28 When will Christ reign? (cf. 1 Thess 4v15-17 et Rev 20v6-12 et 21v4)
- v 29 Since water baptism neither washes away sin (cf. Matthew 3v13 & Eph2v8-9), nor saves anyone (Luke 23v43) but, is only a testimony of what has happened in one's life, why would someone getting baptized in the name of a believer who had been killed for Christ speak to the world (cf. Hebrews 11v4)?
- Why do those who think baptism is some sort of magical rite that saves someone, also also think that this inspired Word of God somehow contradicts the obligation for each person to come to Christ to save them?
- Vs 30-50 See questions the Bible asks in the outline above.
- vs 51-52 Who will be changed from having "flesh and blood" to have a "heavenly body" without passing through death? (cf. 1 Thessalonians 4v16-17)
- v 53 What is meant by "death is swallowed up"? How does that change your life now?
