v4 When is it appropriate to use "persuasive words" ? cf Ac26v28

v5 Where did Paul want their confidence to be placed ?

v6 What makes this verse a natural new division in the chapter ?

v7 In what way is God's wisdom a "mystery" of things unknown in ages past ?

v8 Why does Paul call Jesus "the Lord of glory" ?

v9-10 How do these verses define divine revelation ?

v11 The word "things" is not in the Greek text. What would be a better word ?

v12 To whom is Paul writing ? Believers or unbelievers ?

v13 Again, "thoughts" and "words" are not in the Greek text. Why not ?

v14 Who is a "natural man" ? Who is a "spiritual man" ?
