Study questions for 1 Thessalonians 2v1-12

(Remember to find the answers in the verses under consideration!)

Vs 1-2 Paul demonstrates the doctrine of free choice by the historical events in the lives of the Thessalonians. How open to the Gospel was the city of Thessalonica?

Vs 3-4 What simple method did Paul, Silas & Timothy use to bring the Thessalonians to Christ?

Vs 5-6 Why did the Thessalonians feel no pressure to be converted? (There are 3 reasons!)

Vs 7-8 Who did they imitate to win the heart of the Thessalonians?

Vs 9-10 <u>When</u> did the apostles (missionaries) find time to "proclaim the Gospel"? Notice that they did not "teach a catechism" as the Roman Catholic Church to inform their members that they are already Christians without their own choice.

Vs 11-12 <u>Where</u> were the Thessalonians **before** they were "called into His Kingdom" (cf. Col1v13)? Were they already "saved since the foundation of the world" or did they need to be saved?
