Study questions for 1 Timothy 1v1-11

(Remember to find the answers <u>in</u> the verses under consideration!)

- V 1 Who commanded Paul to be an apostle (Greek word meaning missionary)? Is there any example in the Bible of someone other than Christ naming another as an apostle?
- V 2 What are the titles given to the Father and the Son in these first two verses? In both of these verses, does our Heavenly Father act independently of His Son?
- Vs 3-4 <u>Where</u> does teaching human interpretations of history (mythology) and trying to split up the human race into exact categories (anthropology) lead? Are either helpful?
- V 5 What should be our objective? Is this kind of love truth based?
- Vs 6-7 Why do some Christians fall into teaching rule keeping? Do they sound authoritative?
- Vs 8-11 When is the law applicable to us? Is the law good (v8)?
