

(Remember to find the answers <u>in</u> the verses under consideration !) [The ESV is highly recommended for accuracy in Bible study.]

V 12 This verse marks a natural division in the text by returning to the subject of verse 1. <u>Who</u> gave Paul the strength to serve as an apostle (cf v1)? Was it then enough for him to just be commanded (v1) to be an apostle?

V 13 <u>What</u> three sins did Paul confess? Were they still sins even though he was ignorant of Jesus' divinity, obedient to his superiors and zealous against Christianity?

V 14 The previous verse speaks of mercy and here we have grace. <u>How</u> are they different? Does he say faith is involved in mercy or grace? (Obviously this faith is that of Paul trusting God and not God's faith in Paul !)

V 15 <u>Why</u> did Christ Jesus come into the world? Was it to heal people or give them the gift of speaking in other languages or get rich?

V 16-17 <u>In whom</u> must we believe in order to receive eternal life? Do the words of praise in verse 17 refer to Jesus, since that is the context of verse 16, saying clearly that He is God?
