Study questions for 1 Timothy 3v1-7

(Remember to find the answers <u>in</u> the verses under consideration!)
[The ESV is highly recommended for accuracy in Bible study.]

- V 1 Paul continues to instruct Timothy on how we should act in church (1Tim3v14-15). What is the first qualification of an overseer (Elder, cf. Titus 1v5-9) in a local church? Are ALL brothers in the Lord required to aim at being an Elder some day?
- V 2 <u>Who</u> is qualified to be an overseer (Elder) according to this Scripture? (There are 7 more qualifications in this verse.) Is a sister in the Lord allowed to be an overseer?
- V 3 *How* would someone be disqualified? (There are 4 characteristics in this verse.)
- Vs 4-5 <u>Where</u> must an overseer demonstrate his capacities in management? Is business management required? (It's surprising to observe that most evangelical churches have worldly successful overseers rather than humble family centered ones.)
- V 6 <u>When</u> is a brother in Christ qualified to be an overseer (Elder)? Is it biblical to appoint a young Bible college or seminary graduate as an overseer?
- V 7 The last of the 15 qualifications listed in this text concerns the unsaved world! **Why** would the unsaved outsiders have a "voice" in who can be an overseer in our midst?
