- V 2 <u>When</u> don't brothers in Christ have equal authority according to this biblical text? Is this an excuse for abuse of one another?
- Vs 3-4a <u>Who</u> taught these rules about work before they were revealed to Paul? Do Mt10v24-25 say God is against positions of authority?
- Vs 4b-5 <u>What</u> is the real motivation behind rebellion against authority? Is Mt22v21 a license for revolution?
- V 6 Where can we find true satisfaction? Is it in things or money?
- V7 Why is it so foolish to live for things? Is this fact known by everyone? Is it ignored?
- V 8 How many things are really essential for this life? Are all other things just bonus?
- V 9 Who are the most miserable people on earth? Isn't this a paradox?
- V 10 What is a root of all kinds of evil, money or the desire? Is it the only root of evil?
