Study questions for 1 Timothy 6v11-21

(Remember to find the answers <u>in</u> the verses under consideration!)

[The ESV is highly recommended for accuracy in Bible study.]

- V 11 When God tells us to flee, refuse, avoid, do not do or 'put off the old man' He always tells us what to 'put on' or do. He never leaves a void! <u>How</u> would you describe each one of the six pursuits of the man of God listed in this verse?
- V 12 The popular "grace movement" sees no need to make an effort to live the Christian life. While we cannot earn salvation nor repay God for it, <u>what</u> does God's Word say in this verse?
- Vs 13-14 <u>When</u> will having obeyed God in this life really count? (cf. 2Th2v8 where ἐπιφάνεια is also used for the 'appearing' of Christ at the Rapture of the Church in distinction from the παρουσία for the 'coming' of Christ to judge the world in 2Th2v1.)
- Vs 15-16 Who is Paul talking about in these verses? (cf. v14!)
- Vs 17-19 Why is it a mistake to live for 'the good life'?
- Vs 20-21 <u>Where</u> did Timothy have his treasure? Is it dangerous to waste our time talking about foolish things and arguments over things we really aren't meant to know?
