Study questions for 2nd Corinthians 12v11-21

Remember to find the answers in the verses under consideration!

v 11 Why does Paul say he had become foolish? (cf 1Cor9v2 the ONLY proof Paul needed that he was a real apostle [missionary])

v 12 This verse is often used to say apostles [missionaries] must perform miracles. If translated correctly, it says just the opposite! The word "by" is not in the Greek. (cf GNT-WH) Rather, the word "in addition" (τε) IS in the Greek. Paul NOT ONLY had the seal of apostleship (1Cor9v2) but, *IN ADDITION* he had the gifts of signs, wonders and miracles. How does this make MORE sense in Paul's argument (v11) that he was not inferior to even the most well known apostles (Peter, James & John, for example)?

vs 13-16 The word "burden" is used three times in these verses. To <u>whom</u> did Paul not want to be a financial burden?

vs 17-18 The verb "take advantage" is used two times in these verses. When did those Paul sent "take advantage" of their position and demand to be paid?

vs 19-21 What was the reason Paul wrote all that he did to the Corinthians? What should be the ONLY reason we might have to defend ourselves this week?
