Study questions for 2nd Corinthians 13

Remember to find the answers in the verses under consideration !

v 1 This chapter stands alone, as v1 is a natural break from Paul's defense of his ministry. After reminding them he is coming, what is the new subject of this chapter ?

vs 2-4 How will Paul handle sin in the church at Corinth on this third visit ?

vs 5-6 Who is the best person to examine your faith ; to be sure Christ lives in you ?

vs 7-9 Why does Paul pray that the Corinthians "do no wrong" (the verb "do" is present active, meaning don't practice sin) ?

v 10 When would Paul like the Corinthians to "get their act together" ?

v 11 How many commands are in this one verse ?

vs 12-14 This is more than a standard salutation. Every word has to do with the subject of the whole book. Where is the Trinity in these verses and how does it answer their need ?
