Study questions for 2nd Corinthians 2v1-11

Remember to find the answers in the verses under consideration!

- v 1 The first word "but" marks a new natural division in this book. The writer now addresses the matter of restoration after sinning believers have repented. What attitude in us should change after someone else repents?
- v 2 Why is it important to NOT always cause others to be sad?
- v 3 How does God prefer that we influence other Christians' emotion?
- v 4 When AND why was Paul afflicted, anguished and in tears?
- v 5 Who is made sorrowful when someone in the church sins?
- v 6 What was the punishment? (cf 1Cor5v11)
- vs 7-8 How should we treat a repentant Christian? Why should we do it immediately?
- vs 9-11 Who will take advantage of the situation to cause division if we don't truly forgive?
