### Study questions for 2<sup>nd</sup> Corinthians 2v1-11

v 1 The first word "but" marks a new natural division in this book. The writer now addresses the matter of restoration after sinning believers have repented. What attitude in us should change after someone else repents ?

v 2 Why is it important to NOT always cause others to be sad ?

v 3 How does God prefer that we influence other Christians' emotion ?

v 4 When AND why was Paul afflicted, anguished and in tears ?

v 5 Who is made sorrowful when someone in the church sins ?

v 6 What was the punishment ? (cf 1Cor5v11)

vs 7-8 How should we treat a repentant Christian ? Why should we do it immediately ?

vs 9-11 Who will take advantage of the situation to cause division if we don't truly forgive ?
