Study questions for 2<sup>nd</sup> Corinthians 3v7-18

Remember to find the answers in the verses under consideration!

vs 7-8 <u>How</u> are the Old Testament and New Testament similar? (The key word is used three times in these two verses, but <u>what</u> does this word <u>really</u> mean if it faded away for Moses?)

v 9 Where did the Old Testament lead compared to where the New Testament leads?

v 10 What is the second reason the New Testament surpasses the Old Testament?

v 11 When did the glory of the Old Testament fade away? (cf Ex34v29-35, 2Co3v7 & 13)

v 12 After three verses that begin with the word "for", as reasons the New Testament is better, why does Paul conclude that we can now speak so confidently about it?

vs 13-18 What mistake did Moses make, that remains the reason the Children of Israel still do not see the surpassing greatness of the New Testament? What happens at salvation (v16)?
