Study questions for 2nd Corinthians 5v10-21

Remember to find the answers in the verses under consideration!

v 10 While still remaining in the subject of "we" Christians, Paul transitions from speaking about our new body in Heaven (vs1-9) to the Judgment that awaits everyone after this life (vs10...) According to this verse, <u>what</u> are the differences between the judgment <u>Seat</u> of Christ and the great white **Throne** revealed in Rev20v11-15?

vs 11-14 Why is Paul "beside himself" persuading men to repent? (He gives <u>two</u> reasons, but inserts vs11b-13 to make sure no one thinks he is proud.)

v 15 Since Christ's death on the Cross shows that capital punishment is required for sin (v14b), how should Christ's resurrection affect us who are saved?

vs 16-17 Referring back to the fact we are looking forward to a heavenly body (vs1-9) where should our center of interest be? (Taking care of our old flesh OR our new man?)

vs 18-20 What is our job description? (Use some key <u>repeated</u> words from these verses.)

v 21 As a reminder of what we proclaim: How does God reconcile a person to God's holiness?
