Study questions for 2 Thessalonians 1:1-10

(Remember to find the answers in the verses under consideration!)

Vs 1-2 Compare these verses using the KJV, NKJV or MKJV. What words are repeated? Is there any relation to being "in" God's family and receiving His grace and peace?

V 3 Why should Paul always give thanks to God? (Two reasons) Should we?

V 4 How are perseverance and faith different? Are persecutions and afflictions different?

V 5 Who will consider persecuted Christians worthy of the Kingdom of God? Is there ever any doubt in God's mind that all who trust Christ enough to ask Him for salvation are worthy?

Vs 6-8 When will the Lord Jesus be revealed as the Just Judge? Would He be a good judge if He did not punish evil people who refuse His offer of salvation?

V 9 Where will those who do not repent spend eternity? Is Hell real?

V 10 Which "day" is Christ going to be glorified? Is this "the day of the Lord"? (cf 2v2 & Eph4v30)
