**Study questions for 2 Thessalonians 1:11-2:4**

*(Remember to find the answers in the verses under consideration !)*

V 11 What are the three requests in Paul's prayer for the Thessalonians ?

V 12 How will God's counting on them to desire and work for Him, glorify Christ ?

Vs 1-2 From where was the false teaching that we will go through the Tribulation (the Day of the Lord) coming ?

V 3 When will the Day of the Lord, His Great Wrath, begin ? The Greek word "ἀποστασία" was not translated but "transliterated" in our English Bibles. It means "departing" and NOT a theological heresy as many have thought. It refers to what Paul just wrote in verse 1. It is "our gathering together to Him" which is the meaning of Rapture ! With that in view, what are the two events before the Day of the Lord and His Great Wrath comes ?

V 4 Why will God judge "the man of lawlessness" ? Let's be honest, is this really true today, is there a Temple rebuilt already or will it all happen after all the Christians are taken out of the world ? Some Christians say we are in the Tribulation now, but that's hard to believe when you look at what this passage is really saying.
