Study questions for 2 Timothy 2v1-5

(Remember to find the answers in the verses under consideration!)

V1 <u>Who</u> wanted Paul to be a missionary (the word apostle is not a translation, but a transliteration of the Greek word $a\pi o\sigma \tau o\lambda o\varsigma$ which simply means missionary)? Did he or any other person make the decision?

What was Paul's mission according to this verse?

V 2 To whom was this letter written? Was he physically the child of Paul?

From where would all Timothy needed come?

- V 3 <u>How</u> did Paul thank God for Timothy? Did he just do it once in a while?
- V 4 <u>Why</u> did Paul want to see Timothy? Did Timothy show his love for Paul? Is it wrong for Christian men to cry?
- V 5 <u>When</u> did sincere faith begin in Timothy's family? If it's the same sincere faith in Timothy, does that mean they were also saved?

One application: Make a list of those you want to pray for daily and use it every morning. If it brings you to tears, so much the better!
