Study questions for 2 Timothy 2v6-14

(Remember to find the answers in the verses under consideration!)

- V 6 <u>How</u> did the ministry of Paul have an effect on Timothy? (cf. The effect on Timothy of the sincere faith of his mother and grandmother, v5.) Did Paul encourage it?
- V 7 <u>What</u> three attributes of the new human spirit God gives when He saves someone (cf. Rm8v15-16) can overcome our fears? Did Paul include himself in this statement?
- V 8 Where does fear of persecution lead? Could Paul's imprisonment terrify Timothy?
- V 9 <u>When</u> did God (v8) give us a holy calling? (Note: He did not give us salvation before the ages began.) Do we need to answer the call to be saved? (God calls, we answer, He saves)
- V 10 When was that call (v9) made very clear? Does the Gospel (Good News story) show this?
- Vs 11-12 For <u>which</u> of the three ministries (v11) of Paul did he suffer (v12)? Was Paul's trust in correct doctrine or in someone?
- Vs 13-14 For <u>which</u> of the three ministries of Timothy 9v13) did he need to trust God's Spirit? Is the <u>presence</u> of God keeping you doing what He called you to do?
