John 21v11

(Our arguments are like a net that can be torn, but the Word of God is always sure.)

Christ is God and our Creator. (John 1v10, 5v23 & 8v58)

He came because of our sins. (John 1v29)

He is the only Savior. (John 14v6)

There will be a judgment. (John 5v28-19)

Good works can't erase the bad ones. (John 3v5)

We have all sinned. (John 3v36)

We all come short of God's holiness. (John 17v25)

Sin results in death. (John 5v24)

God offers eternal life. (John 3v16 & 20v31)

Jesus took the first step towards us. (John 12v46-47)

He is God Himself who came to save us. (John 5v18, 10v33 & 20v28)

He died in our place on the Cross. (John 10v15)
