



- V1 If men appoint elders and deacons (Ac 14:23, Titus 1:5, Ac 6:3 & 1 Tim 3:10), <u>who</u> appointed Paul to be a missionary (apostle = sent one in Greek)?
- V 2 The words "holy" and "believing" brothers are adjectives, not nouns. Therefore these are NOT different classes of Christians; on the contrary, all true believers are "saints". <u>To</u> <u>whom</u> is this letter addressed, believing men or women? (cf. Phil 1:1)
- V 3 To set the stage for this message to men, Paul reminds us of the relationship between God the Father and God the Son. <u>How</u> does Paul start his prayers ?
- V 4 For What two reasons does Paul thank God ?
- V 5 <u>Where</u> did the Colossians get their faith and love? Was it from EARTHLY sources?
- V 6 <u>When</u> did they begin this fruitful life? Notice there are two prerequisites before we can become true believers ; they both prove that Christian faith is not the opposite of reason.
- V 7-8 <u>What</u> person did God use to bring the Colossians to trust Christ enough to ask Him for salvation? <u>What</u> person was following up their progress? Was it the SAME person?
