

## (Remember to find the answers in the verses under consideration !)

- V 9 The masculine personal pronoun "Him" appears 8 times in just 7 verses. According to the immediate context of v8, this pronoun refers to Jesus. <u>What</u> is **first attribute** of Him in whom we have all things to be revealed in this text? Is He just a part of the Godhead (cf. KJV, Webster, Young, Literal, MKJV, RSV, JUB, Darby, Douay, EMTV, Geneva, ABU, ASV)?
- V 10 <u>Why</u> don't we have to look elsewhere for help to live ? Does this mean Christians are **perfect** or does it mean something has been **added** to complete us ? (cf. Col1v28 & Rm8v15)
- V 11 <u>How</u> has Christ **removed** our insatiable appetite for sin? Does this mean Christians are **sinless** or does it mean we are now **freed** to not sin? (cf. Rm6v6, 7v24, Ga5v24 & Col3v5)
- Vs 12-13 <u>When</u> is a Christian buried with Christ? Is someone, like the thief on the cross, who never got baptized by water deprived of being made alive with Christ?
- Vs 14-15 <u>Where</u> did God publicly "nail", for all to see, the Christian's freedom from damnation under the perfect law of God? Although Christians aren't perfect, does the world have any authority left to condemn them? **What difference with this make for you today**?
