How can I draw in the fisherman's net?

Finally, He draw gently on the fishing net, asking open questions that require serious answers.

Remember, we cannot save anyone; we only bring them to the Savior.

Here are 16 classifications of 304 questions Jesus asked.

Remember, when the same question is **repeated**, it must be important!

Study the context of each question; avoid quoting it out of context.
