



Vs 15-16 After revealing all they have "in Him", why does Paul still pray for the Ephesians?

- V 17 The definite article "the" is not in Greek before the word "spirit" so Paul is not talking about "<u>the</u> Holy Spirit", but our a new spirit He has given us (cf. Rm8v15-16). <u>What kind</u> of spirit does Paul pray that the Ephesians receive ?
- V 18 Revelation is not figuring things out, but receiving new truths God tells us about in His Word. It's a gift from God, not an earned work of research. (cf. Gal1v12, Eph3v2-3 & Rev1v1) <u>How</u> will the two truths in this verse help us face the future ?
- Vs 19-23 Reveal another truth we would never know unless God revealed it in His Word. <u>Who</u> is the recipient of the mighty power of God in their lives according to verse 19?
 - V 20 When was this great power first demonstrated?

V 21 <u>Where</u> is this great power being exercised right now without us even knowing it apart from God's Word revealing it ?

Vs 22-23 This truth almost blows our mind. <u>To whom</u> does God give Himself in the person of His Son with all this mighty power? Can we feel weak and helpless in the face of evil after this revelation this week?
