- V1 <u>Where</u> does Paul pick back up this half sentence that he begins, but does not finish in this first verse ?
- V 2 The KJV translates the Greek word **OIKOVOµía** as a "dispensation", whereas the NASB translates it as a "stewardship". In either case, it is "given for you". <u>What</u> must we do with this new stewardship that Old Testament saints did not receive ?
- Vs 3-6 How is the dispensation or stewardship for our time different from the previous?

In v6, <u>why</u> does Paul only write about "the promise" instead of "the promises to Israel" (Joshua 21v45)?

- Vs 7-9 <u>Who</u> was the first person to receive the revelation of this new "administration" ? (**OIKOVOµía** again in Greek)
- V 10-14 <u>When</u> will this new dispensation be known? Let's show to the world that we are saved just like Abraham, Isaac and Jacob without having to keep all the Law given to Moses!
