### Study questions for Ephesians 4v1-13

*(Remember to find the answers in the verses under consideration !)*

V 1 There is a BIG natural division of this book at this verse. Chapters 1-3 reveal truths and Chapter 4-6 apply those truths to life ! How are we to walk through life ?

Vs 2-6 What key word is repeated eight times ? (Remember, a repeated word is what it's all about !)

V 3 Who creates our unity that WE are told to keep ?

V 5 How many baptisms are there, according to this text ? (Many churches will not let you take communion without being baptized in their denomination. Others refuse all water baptism as not good, since all true believers are baptized by the Spirit of God at salvation. This debate is resolved when you look at the communion table, a PICTURE of the **one true** sacrifice of Christ, yet ordered by the Lord to **remind** us of the spiritual invisible reality.)

Vs 6-13 The word "but" marks another natural division. Where do we see diversity in Christians?

V 11 Did God give gifts or gifted people to the church ? (Notice that the NASB adds a word in italics that is NOT in the Greek, but not the ESV.)

V 12 What are the TWO objectives ? Let's aim at both this week !
