Study questions for Ephesians 4v14-32

(Remember to find the answers in the verses under consideration !)

Vs 14-16 Why did God give spiritual gifts according to this summary verse ?

Vs 17-19 How does the world live and act ?

Vs 20-24 What should Christians "put off" and what should they "put on" ?

Vs 22-24 This verse is just like Romans 6v6 where "the old man" was crucified (dead) and "the body of sin" destroyed (**totally** without power). The Bible is clear that we don't have an old man AND a new man (schizophrenia) fighting inside. All it says is we ARE a new creation, a new man in Christ ! If the "new self" doesn't come from our efforts to change, from where does it come according to these verses ?

Vs 25-32 How many imperative verbs (things to do) are in these verses ?

V 30 The 7th commandment of these 10 is the only one about our relationship with God. When could we "grieve the Holy Spirit of God" this week ? (hint: the context verses !)
