Vs 3-4 What are the 7 commands in these verses?

V 5 Who will be excluded from Heaven? (cf. V21, Mk10v17 & Rev21v8)

Vs 6-7 Why should we be careful who we choose as friends?

Vs 8-10 Where does Godly (God-like) living lead (fruit)?

Vs 11-13 If it is disgraceful to speak about the filth of sin, how do Christians "expose" it?

Vs 14-16 Time is of the most importance. When should we wake up and make the most of the time God leaves us on this earth? Let's do it this week!
