Study questions for Ephesians 5v17-33

(Remember to find the answers in the verses under consideration!)

V 17 Here is another natural division marked by the word "therefore". So based on what has just been written, we are to **move on to better things**. <u>How</u> does Paul say we can do this?

V 18 What is the amazing similarity between being drunk with wine and being filled with God?

V 19 Who benefits when we sing?

V 20 When should we give thanks to God?

V 21 To whom should we be subordinate?

Vs 22-24 Where do these verses say a wife may tell her husband what he must do?

V 24 This is the third time in these three verses that a Christian husband is compared to Christ! <u>Does</u> this verse in any way say the wives submission is ONLY in spiritual matters?

Vs 25-33 <u>How</u> should a Christian husband lead? V 27 <u>What</u> is the goal? Let's lead this week by *sacrificial love* and not "to show who's boss"!
