

Remember to find the answers <u>in</u> the verses under consideration !

- vs 10-17 The third natural division of this book begins here with Paul enumerating one by one all those who might have changed the Gospel, but have no right to do it. He begins with himself. <u>Who</u> does he say revealed the exact details of the Gospel to him?
- v 18 <u>What</u> important personality did Paul first see in Jerusalem, who did not tell him to change the Gospel he had received from God ?
- v 19 <u>How come</u> James, the Lord's half-brother, is called an apostle when many people think there were only 12 apostles? <u>How</u> does the mention of seeing James reinforce the fact that no one told Paul to change the Gospel he had received directly from God?

vs 20-24 <u>Where</u> did Paul preach this same Gospel without any Christians opposing it ?

- vs 1-10 <u>When</u> did Paul finally meet the leadership in the church at Jerusalem? <u>Who</u> went with him at that time and agreed with the Gospel he was preaching?
- vs 11-14 <u>Who</u> got carried away later in Antoich by the hypocrisy of rituals? <u>Why</u> should we too be wary of social presure this week when we announce the Gospel?
