Study questions for Galatians 5v13-26

(Remember to find the answers in the verses under consideration !)

v 13 What key word for the following verses is repeated twice in this verse ?

v 14 How can a Hebrew Christian be "free" and yet obey the whole Law given to Moses ?

v 15 Where will using the Law given to Moses to condemn other Christians lead us ?

v 16 Who enables a Christian to overcome being a slave to his own flesh ?

v 17 Why don't we always free to do what we know is right ? (cf. ESV over NASB !)

v 18 How can we do what is right without being slaves to the Law given to Moses ?

vs 19-21 What does our flesh want, and end up leading us to do ?

Where will someone end up who practices these things ? (cf. 1 John 3v2-10)

vs 22-23 Who produces "good fruit" in a Christian's life ?

How does this list differ from what most Christians think is a "fruitful life" ?

v 24 What must we do to belong to Christ ?

v 25 Where does this logic lead us ?

v 26 What are the wrong ways to try to motivate other Christians to obey Him ?

How should we motivate others to follow Christ this week ? (cf. vs 22-23 & Psalm 34v8)
