Let's ask some basic questions to understand the context of this verse!

Writer: "Jeremiah" vs1-2.

Speaker: "Thus says the LORD" v18.

Listeners: "O Jacob my servant" v10.

Context: "the Word of the Lord" 355x in book, "Judah" 165x in ch2-45,

"bring you back" cf. 29v10 in ch29-33.

Key words: "will" 15x, "shall" 5x = all Hebrew verbs in the future tense.

Natural divisions: v18 "I will restore the fortunes".

vs19-22 "I will multiply them" v19.

vs23-24 "Wrath... will burst on the wicked" v23.

Key verse: v24 "In the latter days you will understand it".

Application: v30 "From them will proceed thanksgiving".

Questions: What is the difference between preaching & prophecy?

[forth telling & fore telling]

What is the similarity between preaching & prophecy?

[both are monologues of proclamation]

[both can contain imperatives, but not necessarily]

What is the difference between teaching & preaching?

[explanation & proclamation]

[dialogue & monologue]

How did Jesus do it?

[sitting to teach & standing to preach]

Application : This text is a prophecy, not a sermon.

It is not teaching. cf. v24b
