

Leading others to Christ

Fishers of Men : Drawing in the net is often where we are weakest in leading others to Christ.

John 4v5-42 reveals 15 of the more than 70 “Methods of the Master”.

1. He went to people who had **erroneous** religious practices, v5.
2. He **rested** when He was weary, v6.
3. He asked for **help**, v7.
4. He often led people to salvation all by **Himself**, v8.
5. He used **Scripture** to plant a Seed that would take root in peoples’ hearts, vs9-10.
(cf. Isaiah 55:1)
6. He **knew** the key question about Christ’s person would arise, vs11-12.
7. He again quoted **Scripture** to correct the idea that all religions lead to God, vs13-14.
(cf. Jeremiah 2:13)
8. He led people from their **felt** need to their real need of salvation from sin, vs15-18.
9. He **answered** all questions and used them to led people to the true God, vs19-24.
10. He made it abundantly **clear** who the only Savior was, vs25-26.
11. He was not **bothered** by what other people thought of Him, v27.
12. He **stayed** where He was, waiting for the effect of a changed life to work, vs28-30.
13. He kept His **priorities** straight even when He was tired and hungry, vs31-34.
14. He **encouraged** others to have spiritual vision for a harvest of souls, vs35-38.
15. He spoke the **Word** of God so that others would believe and be saved, vs39-42.
