Leading others to Christ

Fishers of Men : Drawing in the net is often where we are weakest in leading others to Christ.

John 4v5-42 reveals 15 of the more than 70 "Methods of the Master".

- 1. He went to people who had erroneous religious practices, v5.
- 2. He <u>rested</u> when He was weary, v6.
- 3. He asked for <u>help</u>, v7.
- 4. He often led people to salvation all by Himself, v8.
- **5.** He used **<u>Scripture</u>** to plant a Seed that would take root in peoples' hearts, vs9-10. (cf. Isaiah 55:1)
- 6. He **knew** the key question about Christ's person would arise, vs11-12.
- **7.** He again quoted **<u>Scripture</u>** to correct the idea that all religions lead to God, vs13-14. (cf. Jeremiah 2:13)
- 8. He led people from their <u>felt</u> need to their real need of salvation from sin, vs15-18.
- 9. He <u>answered</u> all questions and used them to led people to the true God, vs19-24.
- **10.** He made it abundantly <u>**clear**</u> who the only Savior was, vs25-26.
- **11.** He was not **bothered** by what other people thought of Him, v27.
- **12.** He **<u>stayed</u> where He was, waiting for the effect of a changed life to work, vs28-30.</u>**
- **13.** He kept His **priorities** straight even when He was tired and hungry, vs31-34.
- **14.** He **<u>encouraged</u>** others to have spiritual vision for a harvest of souls, vs35-38.
- **15.** He spoke the **Word** of God so that others would believe and be saved, vs39-42.
