  - c. What part is God's commentary ? \_\_\_\_\_ none
  
2. What was the date of the writing ? (cf. Rev1v9-10) \_ (90-100AD /1912-1922 years ago)
  - a. When will the events take place ? (cf.Rev4v1, 6v17, 7v 9&15) \_ (during future wrath)
  - b. What were the contemporary events ? (cf. Rev7v14) \_\_\_\_\_ (The Great Tribulation)
  - c. Where does this text fit in God's plan ? (cf.Rev7v17) \_\_\_\_\_ (Salvation in the Trib)
  
3. Who were the first readers ? (cf. Rev1v4) \_\_\_\_\_ (7 churches of Asia)
  - a. To what group of people did they belong ? (cf. Rev2-3) \_\_\_\_\_ (Gentile Christians)  
 Believer ? Pre-Israel ? Israel or Gentile ? Christian ?
  - b. Why were they being addressed ? (cf. Rev1v3 & 7v13-14) \_ (Blessing of revelation)
  - c. What was their relation with the writer ? (cf. Rev1v9) \_ (Fellow believers & sufferers)
  
4. What are the obvious divisions of the text ? (cf.Rev7v9-10, 11-12, 13-17) \_ (3 dialogues)
  - a. When does the subject change ? (cf.Rev7v10, 12&14) \_\_\_\_\_ (New reason to praise)
  - b. What are the different grammatical forms used ? (cf. Rev7v9, 10...) \_ (Nar& quotes)
  - c. When does the speaker change ? (cf. Rev7v9, 11 & 13) \_\_\_\_\_ (When others finish)
  
5. What key word is repeated ? (cf. Rev7v9,10,11, 15 & 17) \_\_\_\_\_ (Throne 7x)
  
6. What is the message ? (cf. Rev7v11 & 15) \_\_\_\_\_ (All angels, elders (Christian), creatures & tribulation saints will worship God because He is on The throne.)
  - a. What simple sentence summarizes it ? (cf. Rev7v11) \_\_\_\_\_ (God reigns)  
 One sentence with one subject, one verb and one object !
  - b. How does this relate to every other part of the text ? (cf.Rev7v9,11,15) \_\_\_\_\_  
 \_\_\_\_\_ (Whether they stand, fall or serve it will all be in worship)
  - c. Where in the text is this message most clearly stated ? (cf. Rev7v11) \_ (Key verse)
  
7. What is the application to my life today ? (cf. Rev7v14-15) \_ (There is a reason to worship)
  - a. What simple sentence with an imperative verb summarizes it ? (cf.Rev7v15) \_\_\_\_\_  
 \_\_\_\_\_ (Go before God's throne)
  - b. How does this differ from the first readers' application ? (cf.Rev7v16-17) \_ (Time)

c. When can my application be implemented? (cf. Rev7v12) \_\_\_\_\_ (Now & forever)

- 5) Fill in your notes with helpful observations that you find, but make sure that none contradict what you have found directly from the Bible.
- 6) If you find that you are way off track according to the commentaries, humbly start over.
- 7) Put into practice the application for life that you have discovered as soon as possible.
